DESCRIPTION:

D.F.E. (Drain Fly Eliminator) is a thickened concentrated gel that clings to pipes and traps, coating organic material. Aerobic and anaerobic bacteria strains rapidly multiply as they digest the food source, doubling in number every 20 minutes until the food source is gone.

WHERE CAN IT BE USED?

D.F.E. can be used in restaurants, bars, kitchens, hospitals, nursing homes, prisons, funeral homes, apartments, kennels, clinics, port toilets, marinas, septic tanks, or wherever organic matter is present in drains.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Shake/Stir well before use.

General Odor Control: To eliminate odor caused by spoiled food, vomit, decomposed animals, waste receptacles – spray directly on malodor and allow bacteria to work. The added fragrance will quickly neutralize any odor.

Grease Traps: Pour directly into sink or pip closest to the trap, typically at night. Flush down with a cup of lukewarm water. Use 4-5 ounces daily for traps less than 20 cubic feet. For larger traps, used 8-10 ounces daily.

Drain Lines & Down Pipes: Use 4 ounces for each 2 inches of pipes size, 2-4 times weekly.

Carpet Deodorizing & Organic Waste: Apply directly to malodor and allow bacterial action to work. The added fragrance will quickly neutralize any odor.

Porta-Toilets: Add 1 pint per 25 cubic feet for initial treatment. The use 8 ounce per week. Pour directly into toilet. If tank is clogged and odorous, add 1 gallon directly through tank manhole

Recreational Vehicles: Initially use 2 ounces per gallon of water. Maintain at 1 ounce per gallon of water. For use at a dump station- use 1 gallon per 50 gallons tank capacity. Maintain at 1 pint per week.
